Introduction / Overview

Lyme Regis is a town in west Dorset, England, 25 miles west of Dorchester and east of Exeter. Sometimes dubbed the "Pearl of Dorset", it lies by the English Channel at the Dorset–Devon border. It has noted fossils in cliffs and beaches on the Heritage or Jurassic Coast, a World Heritage Site.

Type of Event: An all day, inclusive event along Lyme Regis seafront.

The event will include:

Music performances by B Sharp and local community participants, under the Shelters on Marine Parade

Busking performances by B Sharp and local community participants, in various locations along Lyme Regis seafront

Drumming workshop

Pop up Choir

Early Years Music making

Creative making workshop

Terrain: The performance will be located in the Performance Area and Marine Shelters and at other designated areas along the seafront. The audience will be able to access the performance area along the flat level tarmac route along the seafront.

Workshops and activities will take place either under the Shelters on Marine Parade or in the Jubilee Pavillion. Participants will be able to access the workshop areas along the flat level tarmac route along the seafront.

Duration: All day event from 11.00am – 5.00pm

Seated/ standing:

Performance area/Marine Shelters: Seated/Standing. there will be limited seated available at this location

All other areas: Standing. There will be no specific seating provided for the audience. There are a few public benches, and integral seating areas along the seafront.
