You'll work alongside experienced technicians and production staff supporting a multi-site, outdoor/venue-based festival featuring live busking performances and programmed acts across Lyme Regis seafront and surrounding venues.

Key Responsibilities

- Capture high-quality photography and/or short-form media content during the festival
- Document live performances, audience engagement, and behind-the-scenes moments
- Work collaboratively as part of a small youth media team
- Follow a basic creative brief provided during training
- Deliver usable content for post-event promotion and archives

- Aged 16–25

- Experience or current study in media, photography, film, or content creation
- Confidence using a camera or smartphone for visual storytelling
- Ability to work in a busy outdoor festival environment
- Interest in live music, youth arts, and community events

- Storytelling in fast-paced environments
- Health & safety on site
- Working as part of a creative team
